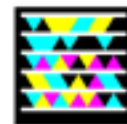

Today this passion play involves 2000 performers, musicians and stage crew. All 2000 are residents of the village.

For you and me the residents prepare months and months in advance for this once in a lifetime experience starting with their beards and hair growing for the different acting parts of the play. They practice through those wintery, cold, snowy days for which Germany is well known.

During the day most of the actors are working their day jobs as they look forward to the evening and weekend play practices. There are bankers, carpenters, ministers, housewives, mothers and fathers who love blessing visitors from all over the world who come to see the play once every ten years. The Virgin Mary has even been played by an airline stewardess. All of the cast believe that it is a privilege to be in the amazing play that takes hours to present.

The play is a once in a lifetime experience. If we miss it this year of 2010 we won't be able to see it again until 2020. How old will you and I be then? Will we be young and healthy enough to do it in 10, 20, 30 years from now? Another once in a lifetime experience!

The following 10 questions are designed to help you sharpen your ability to 'do what you can, with what you have, where you are'.

What matters most? Really dig into your business concepts, processes, strategies, ideas, technologies, etc. and press the reset button. Engage your team and clarify your priorities, at least for this first quarter, and do it again for each to come. Make that combined commitment and check-in with each other every week for a progress report. Focus and build on what matters most!

What is the one problem you can turn into an opportunity? Look at your current challenges through a new lens of possibilities. What past successes can you apply to this issue? Remember, we all grow our businesses by building on strengths, not fixing weaknesses.

The cake had written across the top: “Never Mention 2009 AGAIN!” Of course we all found this hugely amusing because for most of us this year just past has been a challenge. Okay, okay – I’ll admit it -- it’s been downright DIFFICULT!

People have been faced with financial crisis – job loss; fear has dominated the media. 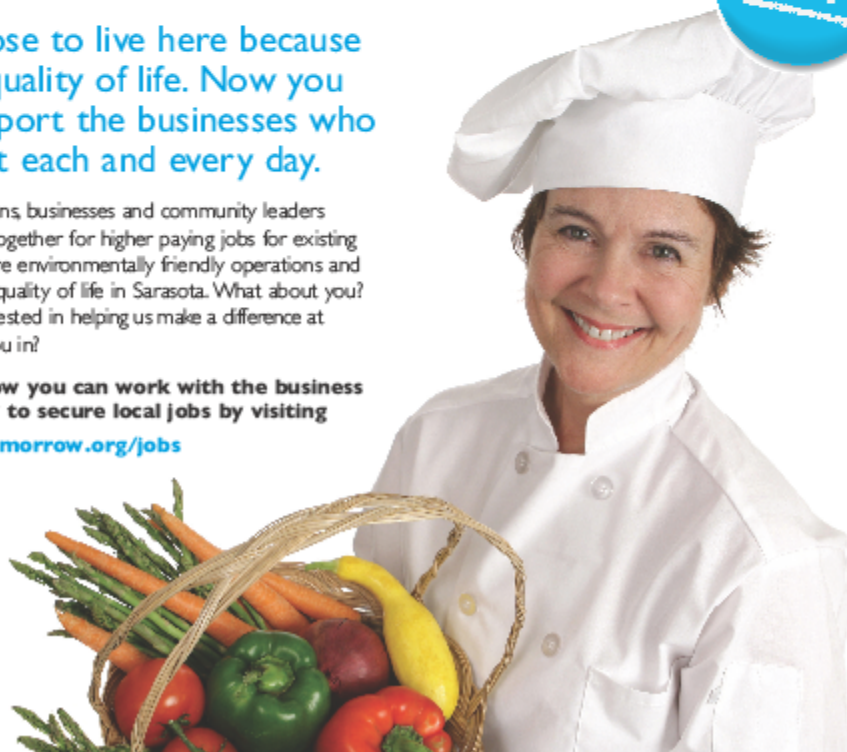

When we have a family, we are so grateful. In the beginning it's amazing. You now know why you're alive, you feel content, things just seem to be....blissful. You know that you made the right decision, life is good!

Speed up life about 13 years. Wow! Did I enter a new planet or what? How could things be so full of unexpected attitude, outrageous expectations, and the loss of self? Where did time go? You told them no one in the house....so they bring their friends over and sit outside! You took their phone away, so they're on their friends. You said no more use of the computer...no problem, I'll just use my friend's laptop. WOW!

 **Keep it E-Friendly - don't print this issue unless you really have to!**

Do you get the message? It's not a power plan, it's a prayer plan. When we don't find time to spend with our Higher Power - God, in my case, we can get so caught up in this chaos that can and will be brought into your home. When we ask for guidance and wisdom to be healthy, loving parents, don't forget to ask for wisdom and clarity.

The Best of From Here to Hired... Questions about Employment.

LOOKING FOR A JOB? Ask the expert!

Question: *I heard from a friend that there may be an opening at her company – should I send my resume or go in person?*

Answer: Get your friend to give you details about the job – EXACTLY what the required skills are – why the job is open – what kind of personality would work in that position – EVERYTHING you can think of. Do your own research as well – find out everything you can and then **tailor** your resume to show **everything you bring to the table that fits the job description**. A personal referral is a great way to get in the door – so ask your friend to hand deliver your resume to the hiring manager (NOT to Human Resources) with a personal recommendation!

Question: *I'm nervous about my upcoming interview. I haven't interviewed in long time and I'm not sure how to prepare.*

Answer: The most popular interviewing technique in use today is “Behavioral Interviewing” In these interviews candidates are given a ‘situation’ that they might encounter in the job for which they are interviewing -- or that they might have encountered in previous jobs – typically a difficult situation such as dealing with a difficult co-worker or irate client – and asked how they would handle or have handled similar situations. The best thing to do is to PRE-THINK the activities of your previous jobs that directly relate to the position for which you are interviewing. Think of anecdotes about how you handled situations Prepare to share how you handled difficult situations, how you handled stress, how you handled mistakes you have made....be sure you have examples that show your resilience and job mastery. Don't be afraid to take time to think before you answer. It helps to work with a coach or a friend and rehearse answering questions until you feel comfortable.

During the interview ask the interviewer to tell you what he or she is looking for – and be prepared to discuss how your background fits the job description. Whenever possible when discussing your accomplishments – mention the RESULTS you created for your employer – how much did you increase efficiency? How much did you increase customer satisfaction? How much did you increase revenues? Know what you contributed to your previous employers – and be ready to discuss it! RESULTS sell you!

Question: *I have been out of work for awhile – I moved to a new location and I had some savings – so I took my time. Now I'm concerned about the ‘hole’ in my resume. How should I handle this?*

Answer: Let the employer know that when you relocated you **planned ahead** to take time to get settled in your new environment. If you did any volunteer work – or performed any tasks related to your career –(for example if you're a programmer – did you help friends trouble shoot their computers or install new software?) -- you can list these as Volunteer or ‘Independent Consultant’.
